- I) Asian Community Advisory Council

- III) Meeting with Chancellor

 - A) Last year's issues/priorities will be disseminated for review by members before Chancellor's meeting
 - B) Priorities from last year – Unsettled
 - 1) "Increased space for AARCC and GLAS" should be a single point on priority list
 - 2) What have we done in the interim between meetings with the Chancellor to make the spaces more hospitable
 - i) bought furniture to make rooms more comfy
 - 3) Did not get grant funding from Part F
 - 4) Academic advising for Asian American students
 - i) **Keep on list of priorities** – students are confused about where to get cultural and academic advising

- a) There are no other advising services targeting Asian Americans
 - b) Grant Part F can't support it
- 5) Shared priorities
 - i) Possibility of collaborating with other status committees to push issues
 - ii) Implement that we are a AANAPISI institution (like CCSL and the HIS status) to make our arguments
- C) Upcoming issues
 - 1) Are Asian Americans still underrepresented?
 - i) IBHE considers Asian Americans underrepresented, but campus does not
 - ii) Minority status impacts certain institution's ability to apply for grants specifically for underrepresented groups
